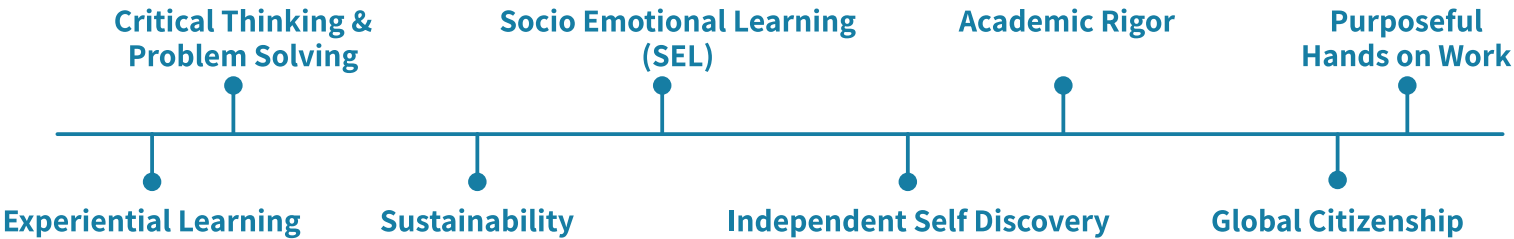
ACADEMIC OVERVIEW

- ⇒ The academic session comprises of two terms- Term 1(April to September and Term 2 (October to March).
- ⇒ Junior Wing (Toddlers - Class III): Between 7:55 a.m. to 2:45 p.m., with staggered timings for different classes.

ASSESSMENT OVERVIEW

Grade 9 (IGCSE)

Cyclic Assessment Pattern: Each term includes formative and summative assessments.

Assessment Components: CCQs, activities, practical work, and written examinations.

Marking Scheme: Marks are allocated based on the weighting factor of each component.

External Examinations: Conducted by the Cambridge International Examinations board at the end of the two-year IGCSE program.

Grades 9-12 (CBSE)

Assessment Structure & Components: A comprehensive assessment system is in place, combining formative and summative assessments. Includes periodic tests, internal assessments, projects, assignments, practical exams, and term-end examinations.

Marking Scheme: Marks are allocated based on the weighting factor of each component.

Rubric Based Evaluation: Emphasizes on assessing the development of problem solving skills through critical challenges.

External Examinations: Conducted by CBSE for classes 10 and 12.

Grade 4-8 (Cambridge+CBSE)

Assessment Structure: A balanced approach combining subject proficiency, enrichment activities, practical work and CCQs.

Assessment Components: Periodic tests, projects, assignments, seminars, and research based essays.

Marking Scheme: Marks are allocated based on the weighting factor of each component.

Rubric Based Evaluation: Emphasizes on assessing the development of problem solving skills through critical challenges.

In addition to this, our formative assessments, combined with a focus on cultivating habits of mind through Round Square discoveries, foster a well-rounded and holistic development for each child.
